**Secretary** The minutes of the last meeting were reviewed and accepted. Two contacts were received through the Intergroup web site, with one resulting in someone now attending meetings regularly.

**Treasurer** Current balance is \$531.42 after spending \$100 on food for the Service Workshop; flyers received in the Intergroup mailbox were passed around.

**Jails & Institutions** The Midland County Jail men's meeting is up and running, but women are needed to conduct a women's meeting at the same time, 10 AM on Thursdays.

**Answering Service** Steve passed around the on-call list, which needs more men for days and more women for both days and evenings. After it is filled out better, he will make copies of the list to distribute to those who are on it, in case someone is called but needs to pass the call to another person. Steve will also follow up with the service and instruct them on contacting an on-call person from the area appropriate to the called. The service covers Saginaw, Midland and Bay City and sometimes Midland people have gotten calls from Saginaw. Theron will compile a list of area treatment facilities for reference.

**Public Information** Theron will contact the guidance counselors at the two local High Schools to see whether we can help them with information or possibly speakers.

**Intra Area Meeting:** Bill M. reported that Ron A. from St. Johns, MI was elected as the new Area delegate. Officers were nominated for the Area elections scheduled for next month in Adrian.

**Old Business:** A Service Workshop was held as planned on Saturday, November 4 at the Union Hall. Attendance was about 30. This was fewer than hoped but many of these were relatively new in the Fellowship, including some from the 1016 house. The workshop was a good chance to talk with them and provide information about why A.A. service is beneficial and what kinds of opportunities are available.

**New Business:** See committee reports. No new general Intergroup business.

The Intergroup meeting was adjourned at 7:50 PM.
