The meeting was held at the Unitarian Hall on Jefferson Ave. at 7:00 PM. Committee reports:

Secretary	Theron passed out copies of the minutes of the last meeting, which were read and accepted.
Treasurer	Steve was not present so there was no treasurer's report.
Jails & Institutions	Bill M. reported that the Saturday night meeting at the Freeland prison is studying the 12 & 12 and there has been some good sharing. Midland County Jail still has not decided on whether they would allow a women's meeting to start up or when it might be.
Public Information	Lynn S. reviewed the GSO videotape "Bill's Own Story" and there was extensive discussion about how it might be used by groups or individuals. It was decided that Bill's Story would be used for a workshop, tentatively scheduled for March 2 at the Union Hall. Any groups or members wishing to borrow the videos would be asked to put down a deposit equal to the purchase price (\$15) which would be refunded when the tape was returned. If the tape didn't come back then another copy could be purchased. The other videos from GSO are still being evaluated by other members, who will report at the next Intergroup meeting.
Answering Service	The answering service finally provided the detailed information on number of calls and types of contacts that Bill had been requesting for some time. It looks like they are doing a good job for us and the general feeling among the group was that it is a worthwhile thing to continue.

Old Business: Several people brought in meeting agendas from their groups. The secretary will use these to compile a generic suggested agenda for groups that don't have one. It was felt that this would be helpful in encouraging newer members to chair meeting, since they would have some printed guidelines they could follow. The suggested agenda will have a number of items on it, any of which may be used or omitted at each group's discretion.

New Business: The joint New Year's Eve party, which Carl O. has been coordinating with Bay City Intergroup, will be at the Kawkawlin Township Hall on Parish Road, near M-13.

The Intergroup meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM.
