<b>Secretary</b>	Theron passed out copies of the minutes of the last meeting, which were read and accepted.
<b>Treasurer</b>	Current balance is \$698.13 before paying expenses of about \$135 for the 4 <sup>th</sup> Step Workshop. Steve passed around the fliers received in the P.O. box.
<b>Jails &amp; Institutions</b>	The county jail women's meeting needs more women volunteers to help Carol D.; the men's jail meeting has enough volunteers and regularly gets about 12 inmates. Joe H. reported that the St. Louis prison has six meetings a week. Steve W. said that the H.G. Swift outpatient treatment center has made some changes in their program and is now placing more emphasis on attendance at A.A. meetings. They are stocking A.A. literature and have asked for members willing to visit the evening outpatient sessions to talk with clients. The outpatient sessions are 3 hours long, starting at 5:30 PM on weekdays.
<b>Public Information</b>	Theron played some radio public service announcements (PSAs) available from GSO. It was suggested that WSGW and the local Christian stations be contacted to see if they would play any PSAs. Lynn S. and Bill M. will help Theron with this.
<b>Answering Service</b>	The April was the highest so far, indicating the highest number of calls to date.

**Intra Area:** Intra-Area was in Saline but no one from Midland attended this month. Because of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday it will be on the second Sunday next month, however the Intergroup meeting will be on the first Sunday.

**Announcements:** The Sunday afternoon meeting has chosen the name "The 12 & 12s". Flyers are out for the sober picnic in Sanford on July 6.

**Old Business:** The 4<sup>th</sup> Step Workshop was held as scheduled on June 1, with 37 people attending, including a good-sized group from the 1016 house treatment center.

**New Business:** No new business was presented.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM.
