The meeting was held at the Unitarian Hall on Jefferson Ave. at 7:00 PM. The meeting was chaired by Steve W. and opened with the Serenity Prayer. Committee reports:

Secretary	The minutes of the October Intergroup meeting were reviewed and accepted.
Treasurer	The current account balance is \$1,368.14, with a few bills still coming in from yesterday's workshop. Steve passed around flyers received in the mail.
Jails & Institutions	Bill reported that the prison meeting averages 12-16 members attending. Theron said the jail meeting would be studying the 12&12 and would need some books. The 1016 treatment center has a new director and they have asked several members to come on weekday evenings for informal discussions with treatment groups. Most of those present volunteered.
Public Information	The Midland AA web site statistics showed 2064 user sessions for October, about the same as last month. We also got one contact through the site asking for more information.
DCM Reports	Dan and David are comparing our local meeting list with the one GSO has for our District to come up with a correct, up to date list for both and to see whether any groups have not been registered. They will then encourage groups with a GSO to choose one.

Intra-Area: The Intra-Area was in Flint; delegate Dennis S. gave his report. The December Intra-Area meeting will be in Adrian.

Announcements: The Auburn Wednesday night group appears to have ceased meeting. MCYPAA 25 is coming up the weekend of November 22 & 23.

Old Business: The recovery workshop yesterday had an attendance of about 45 people. Total expenses will probably be about \$350. The group authorized Jack W. to make a donation of \$125 to St. Agnes Church for letting us use their hall because they had not asked for any rent.

Valley Plaza Resort has requested information on expected attendance and layout for the 2005 State Conference so they can quote pricing. This venue has been used previously for a state conference some years ago.

New Business: Jack suggested a service workshop on either March 6 or March 13, 2004 using the theme from the 2004 General Service Conference. He will check on the availability of the hall at St. Agnes Church. Bill asked the group to approve the purchase of \$397 worth of sobriety medallions. Bill will be passing the task of keeping the medallions stocked to Dennis T.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.
